

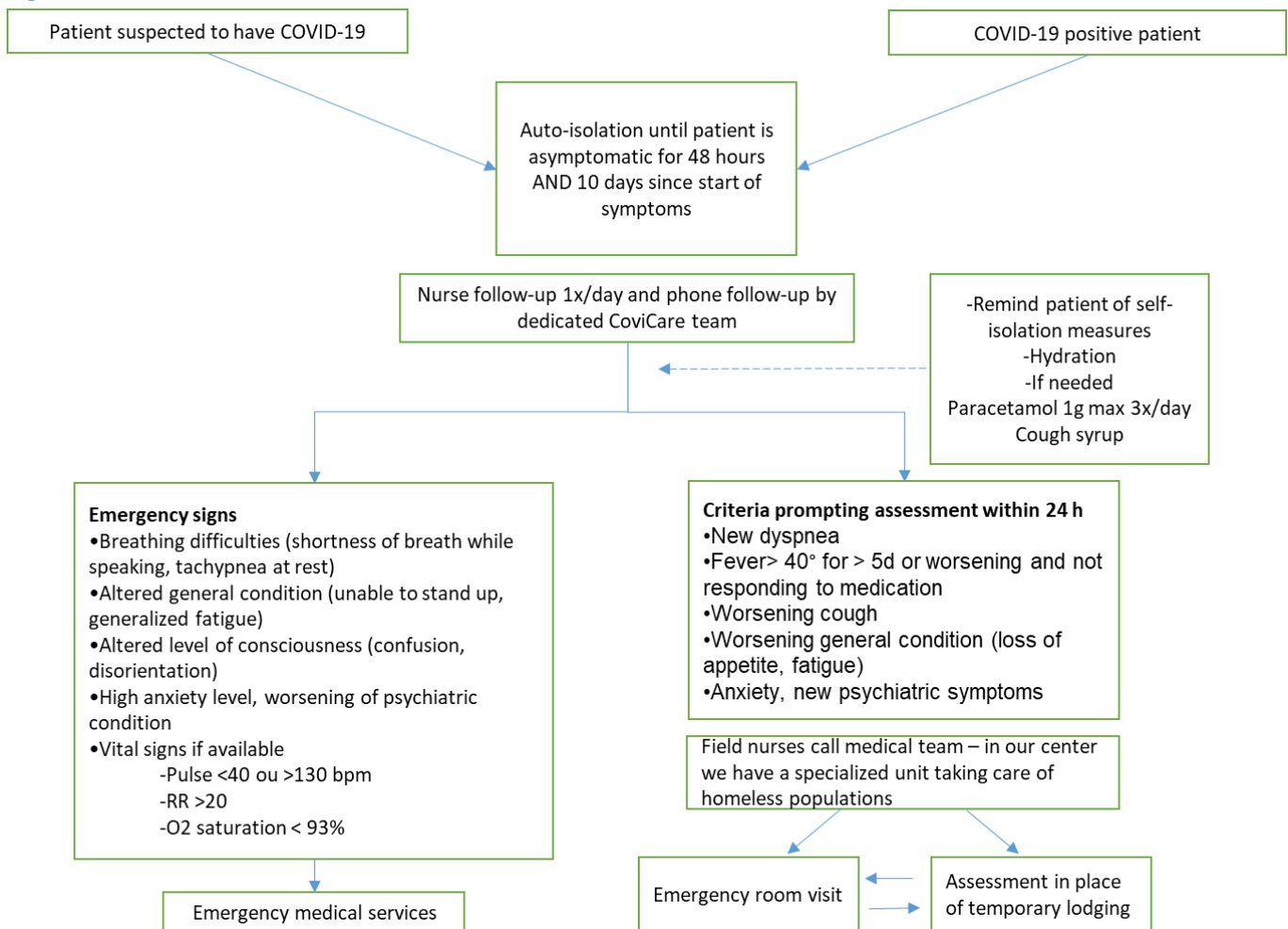
## Vulnerable populations (homeless, asylum seekers, elderly, people with disabilities)

### HOMELESS POPULATIONS

#### Housing

A local social emergency system has been activated with homes and shelters available to all homeless people, specialized homes for vulnerable people who are COVID-19 positive. A free telephone number has been made available to all people in situation precariousness.

### ASYLUM SEEKERS LIVING IN COLLECTIVE HOUSING

The migrant health program, a specific unit of our ambulatory care center, takes care of asylum seekers and has a presence in all collective housing accommodations to monitor patients on a regular basis.

## ELDERLY

The community geriatrics unit, a specific unit of our ambulatory care center, monitors elderly people at home and is available to accept new patients during this period, particularly in the absence of a primary care doctor. A specific post-hospitalization program for the elderly is put in place (Cf. Post hospitalization)

## PALLIATIVE CARE

A palliative home care consultation is available to all patients. The palliative care team offers:

- Assessment of the overall situation and needs
- Assessment and management of symptoms (physical and mental health)
- Advanced care planning
- Support to caregivers
- Support to health care teams
- Help with ethical questions and decision-making
- Information and orientation in the health care network

## PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

A specific consultation with possibility of in-home assessment is available to people with disabilities.
